In Memory of David Hickey



I did not know David for very long--perhaps three or four years. I got to know him mainly through his going to WoodCraft each Thursday night for a few hours of carving. He usually was there before I arrived and would be working on his project with a calm and determined attitude. I noticed that he would almost always be working on a subject that had a religious theme, usually angels. When those of us in the group asked him how many he was going to carve he would just laugh and say he didn't know yet because he gave them away to friends and family members. I never heard David make a derogatory remark about anything or any body, and he was always in the best of moods, joking with us about something or other. On Thursday night 16 December he was there as always but on Thursday night 23 December he did not show up and those of us there were asking each other if anyone knew why David did not show up. The next day, when David's son called me about his death I was dumbfounded!! I could not believe it and asked his son over and over if he was sure, what happened, etc. I don't think I have ever had anyone's death, outside of a family member, to hit me so hard. I have seen a number of fine young men lose their life during my years in the service with 13 of their names on the Vietnam War Memorial Wall, and others lost during training and every day operations. For some reason or other, David's death hit me a lot harder. Perhaps it is because in the service we knew that on some missions not everyone was going to make it back. With David it was different. He appeared to be the picture of health, and was still so young. And his personality was contagious--you just could not help but like the guy. I have thought of him every day and am sure I will do so for many days and years to come. I'll bet those of you in the carving club will miss him as much as I do and I know that he is looking down on us now with that smile of his and encouraging us to continue on with our own efforts. I feel especially privilaged to have known him.
