

This brand is the only bleach that will do a good job of bleaching wood. It can be ordered from Woodcarver's Supply (woodworker.com). Following a discussion of this recommendation it was decided to consider it further before purchasing.

Robert Holland announced he had asked Floyd Redican, president of the Caricature Carvers of America, to come and teach a class in Austin. A sign-up sheet was passed around for those interested in participating in the class.

The blank of the month was brought by Clarence Born who had blanks for six different dogs and go-bys for each.


Several carvers remained to carve and visit at the conclusion of the meeting.
